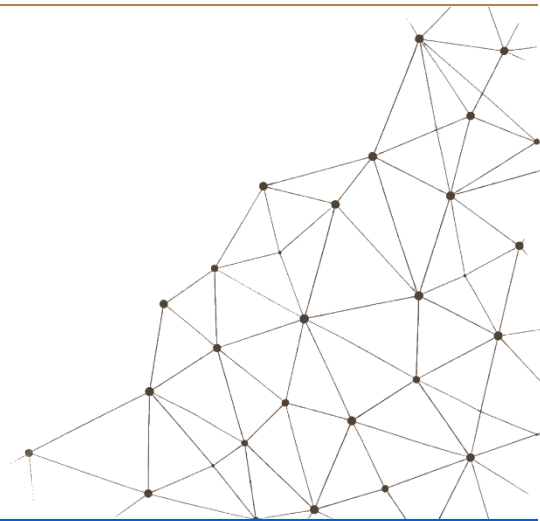


Privacy Policy
